Beautifully appointed and spacious log cabins are replete with creature comfort amenities but do NOT offer WiFi or Cable TV. Office is located on US 65, at the top of the hill just south of the Buffalo River and is very easy to find. Cabins are very private, scattered along a forested gravel road across from the office, and are also easy to locate in the daylight but might be more of a challenge after dark.

Also a consideration, though you can park right next to your cabin all cabins are elevated above grade and ground floor entry is gained by a short flight of steps. If you plan to stay here and will be arriving after dark, make it easy on yourself and BRING A FLASHLIGHT!

Buffalo River Outfitters also offers canoe rental, horseback riding, guided hunting & fishing services. Ten cabins are available, each with a maximum occupancy of 6 to 12 people. Rates per cabin based on double occupancy range from \$120 to \$205 per night. Luxury Cabins offer a whirlpool tub in the bathroom.

This 'plantation style manor house' built in the early 1900s has been meticulously restored to preserve its original ambiance while at the same time incorporating great modern convenience including WiFi. Tastefully decorated with many original furnishing, the setting is luxurious for those who are captivated by antiques. Located just a few short blocks off of U.S. 65 in downtown Leslie, The Killebrew House is very easy to find.

Parking is along the city street in front of the house and some rooms are on the second floor of the dwelling. Breakfast at the nearby (1 block) Leslie Café, serving from 7:30am, is included with every room (5 rooms total) –and- we were quoted a \$10 per room discount from the rates posted on the Internet. Be advised, however, that the two most economical rooms (\$69 each) share a bathroom, but the two rooms at \$79 (each with one bed) and the one room at \$89 (with 2 queen-sized beds) each have a private bath.

Sunset Motel (870-448-3348) & Marshall Motel (870-448-3357)

These facilities are both located on U.S. 65 very close to our offices and factory, however they are both 'old fashioned' motel properties with very small rooms, somewhat awkward parking and minimal amenities. The rooms we inspected were clean and utilitarian, however the exterior of the facilities could be more attractive. The Sunset Motel (\$50>\$60) offers WiFi, the Marshall Motel (\$45) does not.

REMEMBER: If you wish to imbibe alcoholic beverages, this part of Arkansas is 'dry' and the nearest package store is a 30-mile drive on winding mountain roads... so remember to BYOB!!!
